

## WILFRED JASPERS SCHOLARSHIP GUIDELINES

The Wilfred Jaspers Scholarship was established in 2000 for Roslyn High School Alumni. With the dissolution of the Roslyn School District, the scholarship has been made available to college students from the Britton, Langford and Webster School Districts.

Any full time college/university student of **sophomore ranking or higher**, pursuing either a bachelor's or graduate degree, and maintaining a minimum 3.0 grade point average (GPA) is encouraged to apply. High School seniors can apply. However, if they are chosen as the scholarship recipient, the scholarship will not be awarded until they reach sophomore status and have at least a 3.0 GPA. Priority will be given to those candidates who are especially active in their communities, have financial need, attend Midwest colleges/universities and plan to return to Northeast South Dakota to live and pursue their careers.

Applicants may apply as often as they are eligible. Prior awardees of this scholarship (that continue to meet eligibility requirements) are also welcome to reapply. Postmark deadline for applications is June 1<sup>st</sup> of each year.

### SUBMISSION PROCESS

**Part One:** Write a cover letter introducing yourself to the selection committee and detailing (in no more than one page, single-spaced) why this scholarship will assist you in meeting your educational goals. This narrative should include an explanation of your commitment to earning a degree, your financial need for accomplishing this goal, and your career plans after graduating. Include the year graduated from high school.

**Part Two:** Attach an official transcript showing proof of academic eligibility and your latest cumulative GPA.

**Part Three:** Create a resume that includes categories and dates for education, extra-curricular activities, community service and work experience.

**Part Four:** Proof-read and mail to: Jaspers Scholarship Selection Committee, 310 5<sup>th</sup> Avenue East , Sisseton SD 57262.
